# Castello di San Fabiano

**S**an Fabiano Hamlet, dating back to 867 AD, is situated in the picturesque Tuscan region of Crete Senesi, to the south of Siena. It's conveniently located 1 hour's drive from Florence and 2 hours from Rome. The castle is surrounded by one hectare of beautiful English gardens. The centerpiece is the main tower, built in the 13th century, adorned with vibrant Virginia creeper that's green in summer and turns deep red in autumn. Adjacent to the tower are the Ancient Stables, farm buildings, and the chapel, which lends its name to the castle.

Built by the Republic of Siena for defense in 1409, later owned by the Forteguerra family and transformed into an elegant villa. In the 1950s, Count Giuseppe Fiorentini acquired and renovated it for hunting. Today, managed by Andrea, Beatrice, and their sons Giovanni, Filippo, and Benedetto, it serves as an exclusive events venue and a romantic "Residenza d'Epoca" B&B.






THE GARDENS

# The Hamlet Square

**T**his garden is divided into two sections by a line of terracotta vases filled with lemons and hortensias. To the east a spacious gravel square, to the west a lush lawn graced by a majestic 200 years old hackberry tree. The tower dominates the area, making it perfect for a welcome cocktail.








## The Stables Garden


**T**he Stables Garden, nestled between the Castle's main building and the Ancient Stables, is flanked by a charming grove of holm oaks to the east. It's a popular and picturesque choice for hosting the wedding dinner, offering a stunning view of the main tower and castle walls.





# The Loggia Garden

**O**n the south side of the Castle, you'll encounter the Loggia Garden. Designed by the English landscape architect Peter Curzon, it resembles an amphitheater with its boxwood bushes. The loggia, featuring five arches draped in jasmine, provides an enchanting setting for your wedding ceremony.








## The Pool Garden



# The Old Stables

**B**uilt as a horses stable, it was later converted into a wheat granary. It separates the main square from the stables garden and it is divided into 3 connected halls each one with its own style and features.

With a maximum capacity of 80 seats it is a good backup solution in case of rain.








# The Courtyard





# The Pavilion

A big loft, recently renovated, measuring more than 300 m<sup>2</sup>.

The building, thanks to its rough white brick wall, the iron trusses and the design lamps, is characterized by an eye-catching industrial-style.
